Statement of intent:

In line with government guidance, we review a child's development between the age of 26 and 30 months to identify any potential areas of concern or additional development needs. Where necessary, we will work with parents and other professionals to put in place appropriate support and intervention.

The progress check reviews the child's development in three prime areas:

Communication and Language

Physical Development

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

It is vital that a child's development is reviewed, and parents and carers have a clear picture of their child's development.

The check is carried out via the child's key person and is assessed through observations.
